Carroll ISD has partnered with Lamar University from Beaumont, Texas, a member of the Texas State University System, to offer an opportunity for certified teachers working in our district to earn a Master's of Education degree in Teacher Leadership or a Master's of Education degree in Educational Administration.

Many times teachers say that they would like to get their master's degree, but it is too expensive or difficult to make it to the classes at night or on the weekend.

This opportunity addresses both issues. Lamar University has developed a program for teachers that will enable them to earn a M.Ed. from their home. The program only takes **18 months** and classes are 5 weeks long with a short break between classes.

The cost of this program is **\$4950.00**, a fraction of the cost of traditional programs!

The Informational Meeting will be held on **Tuesday, May 20, 2008** **at 4:00 pm** at Carroll ISD Administration Center- Cabinet Room.

Entrance requirements: 2.75 GPA on your undergraduate degree (last 60 hours), a valid teaching certificate, a GRE score of 800 or above in the past five years, and official transcripts from prior degrees. If you already have a master's degree and are interested in a second, the GRE is not required for you.
