

# CS1 Summer Assignment 2008

The summer you will be using *JavaBat* to practice and build your coding skills! Javabat is a free site of live Java coding problems created by Nick Parlante, a computer science lecturer at Stanford University.

***IMPORTANT NOTE: You should work on these problems throughout the summer, doing a little each day or each week!***

**In order to receive credit, you must carefully follow the instructions** for setting up your account! You can receive extra credit if you do more than the required amount of exercises! This assignment will be worth a TEST grade in the first six weeks! Students who do not complete this assignment over the summer will be required to stay after school in the fall until it is complete!

## Setup

1. Go to [www.javabat.com](http://www.javabat.com)
2. Click on “create account”. Enter your email address, password, and your name. Please enter your name in the format lastname, firstname. (I will be the only one that will see your name.) Note that your password must be at least 6 characters.
3. Once your account is created, go to **preferences**, and scroll down to **Teacher Share**. Enter my email address: ([woessnel@cisdmail.com](mailto:woessnel@cisdmail.com)) I will be able to see a list of which problems you have attempted, and which you have completed!  
**You must do this correctly in order to receive credit!**

## Assignment

Once your account is created, you need to complete all of the following exercises for full credit. Remember that this assignment will count as a TEST grade for the 1<sup>st</sup> grading period!

**Warmup:** Complete all warm up exercises! (Do 1 or 2 every time you work!)

**Logic:** Complete any 10 exercises. (Your choice!)

**String2:** Complete any 10.

**Array2:** Complete any 10.

**Recursion:** Complete any 5.

**AP1:** Complete any 5.

**Due Date:** **First day of class!** (Points will be deducted for late completion.)
